Waiver and Release of Liability

I acknowledge that horse sports involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury, head injuries, pain, suffering and potential death to an individual, equine or other animal (“Harm”). I agree to hold harmless and release the MHJA from all claims for money damages or any other damage or alleged damage for any injury, property damage, death or any other Harm to me or My Participants resulting from the negligence of the MHJA which is not caused by an intentional, willful, or wanton act or omission or by the reckless disregard of the MHJA^[1]. My Participants and I agree to wear protective gear when participating in MHJA events, even though protective gear may not prevent injuries or other Harm.
